

## Tutorial Pendant «Meryl» par PUCA®



Made by Puca


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## Material :

- 1 Cabochon par Puca ${ }^{\circledR} 18$ mm
- 12 Strass Mesh (SM)
- 3 Grs Delicas 11/0 (DB11)
- 1 tassel $8 \mathrm{~cm}, 1 \mathrm{~cm} \varnothing$
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15), 11/0 (R11) 2 colors, 1x8/0 (R8)
- 1 bail, rings $\varnothing 4$ mm, 1

Cymbal Remata, 1 Chain 60 cm

- Fireline 0.12


1) Pick up 46 DB11 and close

2) Turn work over, place your cabochon and exit like picture

3) Bead 5 Peyote rows with DB11

4) Bead 2 R15 rows and exit like picture

5) Bead 2 R15 rows

6) Pick up 1 R11, 1 bail, 1 R11, exit through the 3rd DB in the same row

7) Pick up 1 R11, exit through the next DB

8) Pick up 10 R11 like step 8. Repeat to strengthen and tie off

9) Thread through the tassel from each opposite R11 and repeat to strengthen to maintain the tassel

10) Repeat step 7 for the next 10 DB

11) For the tassel 3 Pick up 24 DB and close

12) Place your tassel

13) Exit through R11 like

14) Cut the rope

15) Bead 3 R15 rows picture

16) Bead 1 R15 row, exit through the 2 R15

17) Place the Cymbal between the R11, repeat to strengthen

18) You'll now have this
(2) Exit like picture

19) You'll now have this:

20) Exit like picture. Be careful to respect the DB between the R11

21) Pick up 1 DB like step 25

22) Pick up 1 R11 between the central R15

23) Pick up 1 DB, repeat for the length of the pattern

24) Pick up 1 R15, 1 SM, 1 R15 between each DB

25) You'll now have this (:) Exit through the DB of step 24 (top row)

26) Bead 1 R15 row

27) Place a ring to put your works together

28) Pick up 1 R15, pass through mesh, 1 R15 exit through the next DB. Bead the row like step 27. Exit like picture

29) Pick up 3 R15
between each R15. Close your work

30) Congratulations! You
have finished the Meryl pendant!

31) Bead 1 R11 row

32) You'll now have this (3)

33) Another combination of colors
